Founded

Diane Crawford survived cervical cancer in 2009 thanks to early detection and the quick work of her doctors. She founded The Crawford Crew (TCC) less than three months after being diagnosed. Now cancer free, Diane and The Crawford Crew are determined to make a difference.

Mission

Our goal, simply, is to raise money and pour it into patient assistance, education, research, school and community outreach programs for cervical cancer, and other gynecological cancers.

Fundraising

Our primary fundraiser each year is **Raise A Racket for Cervical Cancer AwarenessSM**. In addition, we sell handmade crystal heart pendants, appropriately known as **Hearts of HopeSM**. These pendants are made with Swarovski crystals and silver, and are created by our volunteers. Each year various organizations graciously raise funds on our behalf. Strike Out Cancer, Zumba for a Cause, Gather to Give, Drive Against Cancer, The Pointless Pursuit, and Brews & Beats are examples of events that have raised money for The Crawford Crew over the years.
